A helpful hand at home...

Personal Care Services is non-medical assistance with daily activities that may be barriers to independence wherever you call home. Personal Care Services do not require physician order and are often covered through private pay or private insurance plans including long-term care policies. It may also be covered through VA benefits or Medicaid, depending on state benefits.

Trained and background-checked Care Partner attendants provide services that include:

- Bathing and grooming
- Meal preparation
- Medication reminders
- Dressing
- Light housekeeping
- Assistance with incontinence

Skilled Home Healthcare includes in-home healthcare services, ordered by a physician, for those recovering from surgery or illness, or managing a chronic condition. Skilled Home Healthcare services are typically covered by Medicare. For those who do not yet have Medicare benefits, other forms of payment such as private insurance or Medicaid may be applicable.

- Skilled nursing
- Health procedures
- Assessment and observation
- Rehabilitative therapies
- Teaching and training
- Palliative care
- Care transition support
- Management and evaluation
- Behavioral health

Ongoing medical assistance...

Private Duty Nursing is medical home care provided for children, adults and geriatric patients who need ongoing assistance to manage healthcare needs. Private Duty Nursing is covered by private pay, private insurance, workers' compensation, school districts, federal insurers, long-term care policies, trust funds or Medicaid (known as Medi-Cal in California).

A skilled nurse or certified home health aide provides services that include, but are not limited to:

- Tracheostomy care
- Ostomy care
- Enteral feeding management
- Ventilator management
- Catheter management
- Respiratory and cardiac monitoring

Comfort and peace of mind...

Hospice is specialized, compassionate care to help individuals live out their days with peace, comfort, dignity and respect. Hospice care is available for individuals who have a terminal illness, and life expectancy of six months or less, as certified by their physician. Hospice is generally covered by Medicare and most commercial insurance plans. Some patients may qualify for coverage through Medicaid or VA benefits.

Our Hospice services are designed around the individual's needs and wishes, and may include:

- Pain/ symptom management
- Medications related to illness
- End of life planning
- Massage and music therapy
- Levels of care based on need
- Bereavement support
